ABSENCES FROM CLASS

If your child is going to be absent from class we ask you to send a text message to 0407675990 or email

admin@danceexpressmackay.com.au with the student's name and class missing, please DO NOT message via FB.

Also note that this does not change your term fees in any way.

SAFETY

The studio/teachers are responsible for the students while they are in class. We are not responsible for students who are dropped at the studio well before their class time and left well after their class has finished... Of course, we will do everything possible to keep all students safe while on the premises, but you can help by asking your child NOT to wait or hang out on the footpath... Students in the following classes are not allowed to leave the classroom until collected by an adult at the back door– Ready Set Dance, Ready Set Ballet, all 6 & under Jazz/Tap, Pre-Primary & Primary Ballet classes...

As the teachers all have families waiting for them at the end of the day we would appreciate students being collected no later than 10 minutes after their class has finished.

Please note that in the event of very bad weather (cyclones or severe storms) the studio closes when schools are closed or the radio is telling people to stay off the roads.

EISTEDDFOD/COMPETITIONS

As a studio we participate in the local Mackay Eisteddfod held each year in October. If students are wanting to compete in Solo/Duo sections they must be committed to their classes and practice. Any student wishing to perform a <u>Solo</u> at the Eisteddfod must have sat the corresponding examination if one is offered for their age group ie. Tap Exam = Tap Solo, Jazz Exam = Up-Tempo Modern Solo, Contemporary Exam = Slow Modern Solo, Ballet Exam = Classical/Demi Character Solo. It is highly recommended that all soloists 10yrs & Up attend their assigned conditioning class.

Students involved in group items must attend the correct number of classes to be eligible to compete, please note all students involved in group items must be available for rehearsal during the 2nd week of the Sept School Holidays..

All students who are attending the correct classes are invited to compete, if there is a group section for their age.

Students competing for DANCE EXPRESS are unable to also compete in any dance sections for another school.

Many students also compete in various other competitions around the area. Please advise Miss Bishop if you are interested in travelling to any of these Competitions.

EXAMINATIONS

Students at DANCE EXPRESS are encouraged to take their examinations in Classical Ballet (RAD & COMDANCE), Contemporary (COMDANCE), Jazz (COMDANCE), Tap (Tapatak Oz), Music Theatre (COMDANCE). If you are wanting your child to enter an examination, please be sure you have enrolled in the correct classes—no child can sit for an examination unless they are participating in the correct number of classes per week from the beginning of the year.....Fees & requirements for the exams are the responsibility of the parents, a note is sent home prior to the exam detailing fees and requirements. Please check the 2023 EXAM INFO in this package for all exam details....

ANNUAL CONCERT....

Every year ALL of our students are invited to perform in our annual dance concert on the big stage at the MECC...

This is the day when all students get to feel like a STAR.....

Performance in the concert is completely optional but definitely encouraged. The students work on the routines for these concerts each week in class starting in Term 3, developing their skills in the process and learning the importance of rehearsal, commitment, performance techniques and teamwork... Dressing up in costumes is often the student's favourite part of the year, besides of course, performing in them!!! DANCE EXPRESS is a NO SEW ZONE for parents, all costumes come ready made to put on and dance... A (non-refundable) deposit \$50 is paid at the beginning of Term 3, then the fun begins for the teachers who have the task of costuming every child in the studio. Remember, NO Deposit = NO Costume will be ordered...

The concert date for 2023 is Sunday Nov 19 show @ 10:00am Preschool Concert Sunday Nov 12 shows @ 9:30am & 11:30am

CONCERT FAMILY PACK

Every family in any of our end of year concerts will need a Concert Family Pack (CFP). This is \$85 and includes:

- HD digital copy of the Dance Express Concert applicable to your child-
- Concert certificate (1 per student)
- All digital photos from the concerts (thousands!) ·
- Our limited edition 2022 DE concert t-shirt (only one) which the students also wear on stage for the Finale. Siblings will need to purchase a Concert T'Shirt for \$30.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Below are a few sensible guidelines in the interest of safety, to help keep things calm and orderly at the studio and make sure that students are able to get the most out of their classes without unnecessary disruption:

- No smoking anywhere on the premises, including in our car park & footpath.
- Younger siblings must be supervised (and stay quiet) at all times so as not to disrupt the lessons.
- No running inside the building.
- Students should not enter a classroom without a teacher present.
- Disruptive behaviour is unacceptable, and students will be removed from class after two warnings. This includes talking out of turn in class.
- Only water, no food is to be consumed in the Studios.
- All students are expected to be kind, friendly and respectful of one another both in and out of the studio. We're here to support each other and work as a team.
- Highly competitive unsportsmanlike behaviour in any form by students or parents is not welcome at Dance Express.
- All students phones are to remain inside their bags while at the premises, this includes outside. Phones can be kept inside the student's bag but are not to be used unless it is an emergency where the student will ask the teacher for assistance. Teachers have been instructed to confiscate any phone seen being used and returned to the student at the end of their last class. If there are any issues with this new rule please see Miss Bishop for more clarification.
- When posting on Social Media, students are to understand they are representing DANCE EXPRESS to the public. Please act & post with respect and kindness on these platforms. Any form of bullying, harassment or negative comments will not be welcome.
- When posting on the social media site, Tiktok, students are NOT to be in Studio Uniform or have anything in the video which identifies them as being at DE (like in front of the building or signs) unless the content has been seen & cleared by Miss Brielle before posting.

ROYAL ACADEMY OF DANCE & COMDANCE BALLET EXAMS

Exams are usually held in July/August

Primary = 1 x weekly Syllabus class

Grade One - Grade 4 = 2 x weekly Syllabus classes

Grade Five = 2 x weekly Syllabus classes + Junior Conditioning

Vocational Ballet = 2 x weekly Syllabus classes + 1 x Repertoire class + Senior Conditioning

Repertoire 2/3/4 = 2 x Syllabus class + Senior Conditioning

***Compusory RAD Workshop in the 2nd week of the June/July holidays.

CSTD JAZZ, CONTEMPORARY & MUSIC THEATRE EXAMS

Exams are usually held in June.

ARE UNIFORMS COMPULSORY?

All students are required to own and wear the Studio Uniform at DANCE EXPRESS. For some of the new students, we understand that you may like to wait until the 'make sure you're happy cooling off period' of 4 weeks before you go ahead and purchase the Studio Uniform.

We do, however, require all students to attend each class in uniform throughout the year. We expect all students to own a DE T'shirt....

WHY DOES MY CHILD NEED A UNIFORM?

Overall, uniforms promotes unity and inclusiveness while decreasing the risk of injury in the classroom! At DE, we feel that uniform encourages team spirit and gives students a sense of identity. Uniforms also allow teachers to see movements more clearly, therefore allowing us to correct the dancer's alignment and technique.

WHERE DO I PURCHASE THE DE UNIFORM ITEMS?

Our DE Uniform Items are available at DANCE EXPRESS MACKAY. Our Ballet Uniform and Shoe Requirements are available at DANCEWEAR MACKAY or can be ordered online through Energetiks & Bloch.

PLEASE NOTE:

Please be careful when purchasing 2nd hand uniforms as many are now the OLD uniform. Any uniform with an 'embroidered logo' is no longer part of the studio uniform and we ask it is no longer worn to class.
